## **Check Your Email!**

Our primary means of communication will be via e-mail. Check your e-mail daily, and acknowledge any messages you receive regarding COBC! We'll use the e-mail list on your CAPF31 or resume.

## **Directions to NAS Lemoore**

Arriving by Auto - The Air Station is located on Highway 198, nineteen miles east of Interstate 5 or thirty miles west of Highway 99. Both highways provide easy access to the Air Station. If you drive, the following routes are suggested - VIA Bakersfield take state route 99 north to Visalia, then west on state route 198 to NAS Lemoore. VIA San Francisco or Sacramento take Interstate 5 south to state route 198, then east to NAS Lemoore.

Arriving by Plane - The Fresno Air Terminal is located 40 miles north of the Air Station. If you require shuttle service from the airport, you'll need to request and CONFIRM this service via email. If you do NOT have a written e-mail confirmation from us, you don't have a ride!

## **Arrival:**

COBC will start at 1300 hours sharp on the arrival date. You may check-in beginning at 0900 if you wish, however keep in mind you're on your own until 1300. Please plan on having lunch before 1300 hours. If you're flying and need to fly in Friday evening, make special arrangements with the COBC Commander for shuttle service and billeting.

## **Departure**

COBC will conclude at 1100 hours on the last day. There is no formal graduation ceremony. If you're flying, make sure your flight does NOT depart before 1300 hours on graduation day.

## **Transportation Verification Card**

Please note the Transportation Verification Card in your acceptance packet. Each student must either mail, fax or email the information to the COBC Commander NO LATER THAN TEN DAYS BEFORE ARRIVAL.

## **Uniforms**

The uniform for COBC will be the standard Blue Service Uniform, without ribbons. Now is the time to think about the number of shirts or blouses to bring so you can manage your laundry time. Your uniform will be inspected daily. You will **NOT** need BDUs. We plan on having a formal banquet on the last evening, if you own a Service Dress uniform - please bring it. Again, this is NOT a requirement. Project X will involve water sports therefore bring a **modest** swimsuit and t-shirt for that exercise. Cadets will be allowed to wear civilian cloths during the evening study period and personal time. Lemoore can be HOT and COLD --please check <http://www.wunderground.com> prior to departure to determine the proper civilian clothing to bring.

## **Notebook Computers**

This year, we're encouraging you, if you own a notebook or laptop computer to bring it. It is not a requirement.

## **Laundry Services**

The barracks have washers and dryers. We'll supply laundry soap. In addition, professional dry cleaning services are available for an additional fee.

## **Money \$\$**

Your COBC tuition fee covers lodging and training materials. Meals are paid for individually. You may wish to bring extra spending money for snacks or to have your uniforms sent out for dry cleaning if you wish. Cadets flying should also carry some extra cash in case of flight delays.
