He was not just smart, charismatic, and hilariously funny, but also wise. He could see problems and situations from angles other people would overlook. Capt Kevin Garland lived the kind of life and made an impact of the kind that few can hope to achieve. But if everyone strove for his standard of excellence, the effect would be immeasurable. He was a man who loved his family, his country, and \checkmark his God; he was a great leader, a great teacher and mentor, and a great friend.
